STUDENT'S RIGHT TO CANCEL

A student may cancel his/her enrollment agreement with the College at any time. Cancellation occurs when the student gives a written and signed Notice of cancellation to the Registrar, hand-delivered by him/ herself or mailed to the institution. The cancellation will not be valid if made via telephone, fax, or email or by any third party. Generally, the date of cancellation will be the date Calstone college receives your notice. The student has the right to cancel the enrollment agreement and obtain a refund of charges paid through attendance at the first class session, or the seventh day after enrollment, whichever is later. If the College has given the student any equipment, the student shall return the equipment within 30 days following the receipt of the Notice of Cancellation.

If a student fails to return any equipment within this 30-day period, the College will retain that portion of the consideration paid by student equal to the price of the equipment.
